- Listening to and supporting small business to develop a smart economy
- Reducing the cost of living and improving housing affordability

- Improving the quality of education and making it more accessible
- Working for equality, respect, and inclusion within our diverse communities
- Improving working conditions and reducing waiting times and increasing access to healthcare, aged care, dentistry and mental health services.

I want to make sure the government does more to protect our environment and to stop climate change. I want more people to be able to get electric cars and solar panels for their home. We also need to protect our Australian plants and animals.

In Victoria we have an organisation called an anti-corruption commission. This organisation makes sure the government, local councils, police, and law courts are doing the right thing. I want to make sure this organisation is strong and runs well.

It can be hard for small businesses to get helpful tools. I want to support small businesses to get and use new technology that will help them.

It is expensive to buy everyday items. I want to make it cheaper to buy things. It should also be cheaper to rent or buy your own home.

Our schools, TAFEs, and Universities are good, but they can be better for our students. I also want education to be more accessible to all people.

I want our community in Victoria to be more inclusive of all people. I want people to be treated the same as everybody else.

People have to wait a long time to see a doctor, a dentist, or a mental health professional. It also takes a long time to get into aged care. I want to make sure that people do not have to wait very long to get the help they need.
