Third, I will make sure there are more buses that travel more places and are easier to use. I also want to get Flexi-ride buses that you can book when you need them.

Fourth, I want women and families to have better lives. I think it should be easier for people leaving unsafe relationships or homes to re-start their life. This means a break from paying taxes so they can start a better life. I think parents who start working after a long time of raising children should have a break from paying taxes too.

And fifth, I want secondary schools in the area to teach more subjects. This means more choice for students so they can study more things that interest them.
